Entrance Requirements

To be eligible for admission, the candidates should:

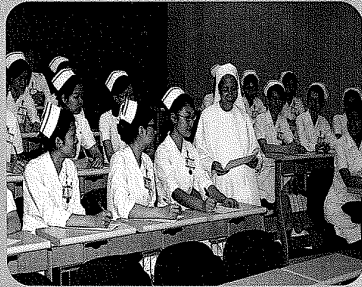
- a. be fluent in oral and written Cantonese, English and Chinese;
- b. satisfy the following educational standard:
 1. passed in 1 AL subject or 2 AS subjects in the HKALE; and obtained 5 passes in the HKCEE including Chinese Language and English Language; OR
 2. passed in 1 AL subject or 2 AS subjects in the HKALE; and obtained 3 passes in the HKCEE plus Level 2 in Chinese Language and English Language; OR
 3. attained Level 2 in the 4 core subjects in the HKDSE Examination (i.e. Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and Liberal Studies); and Level 2 in any 2 elective subjects; OR
 4. completed a Pre-Associated Degree Programme (with cGPA at least 2.5 or equivalent); OR
 5. obtained equivalent qualification.

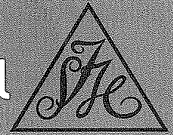
Student recruitment will be announced on St. Teresa's Hospital homepage and local newspapers in July of each year.

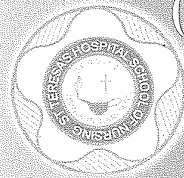

About The Programme

- Accredited by the Hong Kong Council for the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualification (HKCAAVQ) and Nursing Council of Hong Kong (NCHK).

- Upon completion, graduates are eligible to apply for the registration as Enrolled Nurses under the NCHK.

Programme Features

➤ Overseas Educational Visit

Student will have opportunities to visit hospitals and universities in other countries, such as Taiwan, China, Australia.

➤ Personal Tutor System

Student will be assigned a school teacher as personal tutor during his/her 2-year study. It can facilitate learning by providing individual and all-round coaching and support.

➤ Student Quarter

Student quarter will be provided to all students, which is in close proximity to the school and hospital.



Programme Contents

This programme consists of 7 generic and 14 specialised nursing courses, to prepare students to become professional nurses. All courses are compulsory.
